Subject: Part I Crime, Clearance, Arrests, and Calls For Service for 2007

Attached are statistical reports showing preliminary information on Part I Crime & Clearance, arrests, Part II Crime & Clearance, and calls for service (CFS) for the year 2007.

The year 2007 saw a 5.42% increase in Part I Crime over the year 2006.

Violent crime increased by 18.18% (Attachment A)

- There were five (5) murders reported in 2007 as compared to seven (7) in 2006.

CR#2007000989 – This homicide was reported on January 9, 2007. The victim, Robert Neil-Lafo Knox W/M 74 years of age (YOA), was killed by blunt force trauma. The offender was identified as Jim McDuf W/M 25 YOA. This case was cleared by arrest on 03/29/2007.

CR#2007002019 – This homicide occurred on January 19, 2007. The victim, Janie Lee Johnson B/F 25 YOA, was killed by handgun. The offender was identified as Michael Alan Wierer W/M 68 YOA. This case was cleared by arrest on 01/20/2007.

CR#2007002445 – This homicide occurred on January 23, 2007. The victim, Andrea Regina Boyer W/F 25 YOA, was killed by blunt force trauma. The offender was identified as Michael Renard Jackson B/M 37 YOA. This case was cleared by arrest on 02/16/2007.

CR# 2007012546 – Two homicides occurred during this incident, which took place on April 24, 2007. The victims were Chelsea Danielle Rohn, W/F 16 YOA, and Matthew Ryan Brumbaugh, W/M 22 YOA. A firearm was used in this incident. This case remains active.

- There were 108 incidents of forcible sexual battery. This represents a 21.73% decrease from the same time period of 2006. **(The term forcible sexual battery includes the categories of forcible rape, forcible sodomy, and forcible fondling).**

In 33.33% of the 108 cases of forcible sexual battery, the victim had a domestic/familial relationship with the offender. In 92.6% of the cases of forcible sexual battery, the victim knew their attacker.

Seventy-seven percent of the victims were under the age of 18. Eighty-five percent were white, while 14% were black. Eighty-seven percent of the victims were female. The victim sustained some type of observable physical injury in 15% of the cases.

Of the 108 cases of forcible sexual battery, 90 (83%) occurred within a private residence.

- Robbery increased 20.48%, from 83 in 2006 to 100 in 2007.
- Aggravated assault/battery increased by 30.32%, from 465 in 2006 to 606 in 2007. In 28.7% of the cases the victim had a familial relationship with the offender, and in 69% of the cases the victim knew the offender.

Non-violent crime increased by 3.23%.

- Burglary increased 4.9%, from 877 in 2006 to 920 in 2007.
- Theft increased 2% from 2,895 in 2006 to 2,953 in 2007.
- Auto theft increased 11.20% from 259 in 2006 to 288 in 2007.

Clearance Rate (Attachment B)

The Part I Crime clearance rate for 2007 was 42.67%. This represents a .44% increase over the 42.23% clearance rate of 2006. The violent crime clearance rate was 71.79% and the non-violent crime clearance rate was 36.94%. Of all 4,980 Part I crimes occurring during 2007, 6.63% were cleared by exception, while 36.04% were cleared by arrest.

Part II Crime and Clearance (Attachment C)

Part II Crime increased 5.44% in 2007. It should be remembered when viewing such statistics that the volume of reported Part II crimes can be driven by the level of proactive investigation by the agency. For example, an increase in the number of DWI/DUI cases may be indicative of additional patrols targeting such behavior. Such proactive programs can usually be identified by a higher associated clearance rate for the specific offense.

The Part II Clearance rate for 2007 was 73.79%.

Domestic Violence (Attachment D)

Domestic violence is the assault/battery of a victim who has a familial relation to the offender, is co-habiting with the offender, or has had a child with the offender regardless of whether or not they have ever lived together. Domestic violence was involved in 47.16% of all offenses involving some type of assault and/or battery.

Arrests (Attachment E)

The number of arrests, in 2007, was 8,971. This is a 10% increase over 2006.

Call For Service (Attachment F)

Calls for service have increased 11.15% in 2007 as compared to 2006.

Response Times (Attachment G)

The average emergency response time for 2007 was 8 minutes and 49 seconds. The average routine response time was 15 minutes and 44 seconds.
