	ON THE 27th DAY OF July, 2015 AT 5:19 PM THE DEFENDANT, AT 3100 HIGHWAY 17, GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FL 32043 WITHIN CLAY COUNTY, VIOLATED THE LAW AND DID THEN AND THERE: did knowingly commit carjacking by taking control of a motor vehicle though coercion, from the custody of Jennifer Ann Sanders with the intent to temporarily deprive her the motor vehicle, contrary to Florida State Statute 812.133(2)(b). The defendant also, without lawful authority, did use coercion to falsely imprison Jennifer Ann Sanders, against her will, contrary to Florida State Statute 787.02(1)(A). On 07/27/2015, at approximately 1710 hours, I was working in an "On-Call" capacity as I was driving northbound on Highway 17 in Green Cove Springs in my agency issued vehicle. I then observed on the Clay County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) Mobile Commination Terminal (MCT) and Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) screen where a shoplifting (Case number 2015021693) had just occurred at 1995 East-West Parkway (Kohl's). The notes advised that two white females had stolen items they placed inside their purses and fled the scene in a 2001 green Kia Rio. The Kia Rio was displaying a North Carolina license plate number PAH8711 on the rear of the vehicle. I then observed a 2001 green Kia Rio displaying North Carolina license plate number

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PAH8711 on the rear of the vehicle in the 7500 block of Highway 17 driving southbound towards Green Cove Springs. I then positioned my agency issued vehicle behind the Kia Rio as we continued southbound on Highway 17, and I activated my emergency lights as we neared the Black Creek Bridge. The driver/co-defendant (later identified as Hope Davies Gibbons via the LINX and DAVID systems) then slowed the Kia Rio down to approximately 40 miles per hour and began pointing to the right, in what I interpreted as a sign that she was going to pull off to the side of the road when she felt it was safe to do so. At the same time, I observed the front seat passenger/defendant (later identified as Tia Nichole Miller via the DAVID/RMS/LINX systems) begin throwing clothing items into the back seat while throwing what appeared to be price tags out of the front passenger`s side window.

As we approached the intersection of Highway 17 and Russell Road (County Road 209), while southbound traffic had a steady red light, I began activating my agency issued sirens in intermittent burst to try and stop the Kia Rio. The Kia Rio accelerated through the intersection as it almost collided with a large white pick-up truck style vehicle who had the right of way. The Kia Rio swerved to its left to avoid colliding with the pick-up while the pick-up had to apply its brake in an excessive manner. The Kia Rio`s front passenger side tire then collided with the median and ruptured on impact as the Kia Rio then continued southbound on Highway 17. I waited for traffic to clear and it was safe to cross the intersection as the Kia Rio increased in distance from me.

From my perspective, it appeared the Kia Rio had sustained excessive damage and was on the verge of becoming disabled. I then continued to the parking lot of 3266 Highway 17 (Wendy`s) because that was the last place I observed the Kia Rio turn and believed it may have become disabled in the parking lot. I then observed it was exiting the parking lot by 3260 Highway 17 (Winn-Dixie) and turn eastbound on to County Road 315. I was then instructed by Watch Commander/Lieutenant D.P. Mahla #623 to discontinue any attempt to stop the Kia Rio. Once it was safe to do so, I turned off all of my agency issued emergency equipment, and stopped looking for the Kia Rio. The Kia Rio then turned northbound on Highway 17 and continued until I lost sight of it.

After waiting in traffic at the intersection of County Road 315 and Highway 17, I turned northbound onto Highway 17 and proceeded northbound towards the Orange Park Sub-Station (212 Blanding Blvd) where the General Investigation Section (GIS) office is located. I then observed the Kia Rio to be disabled on the east side of the road in the 3100 block of Highway 17. I then observed the defendant and co-defendant exit the Kia Rio and run into traffic. They then stopped in front of a silver 2012 Toyota Venza which displayed Florida license plate number AUNY65 on the rear of the vehicle.

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After they were able to get the Toyota Venza to stop, they then began communicating with the driver/victim (identified as Jennifer Ann Sanders via the DAVID system). I then observed as both the defendant and co-defendant reached into the victim's vehicle and open the front passenger's side door and possibly the rear passenger side door. I then observed as both the defendant and co-defendant entered the front passenger's side seat and closed the door as the Toyota Venza began driving northbound on Highway 17. I later found that the front passenger's side seat is a bucket style seat and only has enough room for one person. Fearing the victim was in danger, I positioned my agency issued vehicle behind the Toyota Venza and activated my agency issued emergency equipment.

The Toyota Venza then stopped in front of 3189 Highway 17, which is approximately 100 yards from where I observed the defendant and co-defendant enter the Toyota Venza. With the assistance of Under-Sheriff/Colonial C.D. Aldrich #5003 and Deputy Sheriff J.B. Wiggins #6938, the defendant and co-defendant were successfully taken into custody and their hands were properly handcuffed and double locked behind their backs. Deputy Sheriff J.H. Drury #7321 responded and secured both the defendant and co-defendant in the back seat of his agency issued patrol vehicle and secured them in seatbelts. Both the defendant and co-defendant refused to answer any questions at that time.

I then spoke to the victim and asked her to explain in detail as to how the defendant and co-defendant came to be in her Toyota Venza. She stated on 07/27/2015, at approximately 1720 hours, she was driving northbound in 3100 block of Highway 17. She was slowing down in the inside lane when the defendant and co-defendant walked out in front of her and waved their hands at her in what she perceived was a hand gesture asking her to stop. To prevent from hitting them, she stopped her vehicle as the defendant and co-defendant walked around to the passenger's side of the Toyota Venza. The victim then rolled down her front passenger's side window and asked the defendant and co-defendant if they were okay. They then demanded she take them to the hospital and she refused saying "no, but you can use my phone to call 911". The defendant and co-defendant then reached into her open window and unlocked the door as the victim was trying to lock the doors from her side. They both then entered the front passenger side seat of the victim's vehicle and told her to drive to the hospital. She advised she was scared for her life and began driving away until she observed my vehicle behind her with my emergency equipment activated and then stopped. The victim reiterated that the actions of the defendant and co-defendant put her in fear for her life and she did not feel free to leave her own vehicle. The victim completed a sworn witness statement.

It should be noted that victim advised she recognized my vehicle with my emergency

Crime Scene Technician (CST) C.K. Clark #7284 responded and processed both vehicles. Deputy Wiggins also completed a Vehicle Inventory form and Horton`s Towing responded and removed the Kia Rio.

D/S Drury transported both the defendant and the co-defendant to the Clay County Jail. I was able to positively identify the defendant and co-defendant as the same two wife females D/S Drury had detained in his agency issued patrol vehicle.

This case is cleared by arrest.
