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On 05/08/2016 I was informed of a string of burglaries (Case Numbers 2016-012438 and 2016-012437) to local Chinese restaurants. While on an area property check of 661 Blanding Blvd I observed a shattered front glass door to the Hunan Wok located at unit 104 with glass on both sides of the door.

Officer A. Spearman and I cleared the building for any possible suspects. Upon entry I observed the two empty front registers open with keys attached. There was paperwork and other office supplies strewn across the floor behind the registers. Additionally, the metal back door was open and the screen door was propped open with a soda crate. I observed footprints and small tire tracks in the dirt behind the business, leading out to Bolton Rd by the dumpster and additional foot prints behind the business. The scene was then secured with crime scene tape.

The victim, Bo Yang, his son, Zhi Yang, and employee Jenny chen arrived at the business and advised they secured the store at 2313 hours on 05/07/2016. Zhi Yang advised the following: He left both registers open and placed the empty till on the counter.

On 05/08/2016 I was dispatched to 1330-145 Blanding Blvd. (Fire Wok) in reference to a burglary.

Upon arrival I found the store's front door had been busted out. The building was searched and secured. I made contact with Anna Boston, reporting party, who advised she came to work at The Pig restaurant at 0345. She went outside for a break at approximately 0515. She said the parking lot maintenance man was blowing the sidewalk off and approached her. He told her the Fire Wok restaurant had a broken front door and asked her to call the Sheriff's Office. Anna Boston completed a sworn written Statement.

I met with involved other, William Pringle, the parking lot maintenance man who said the following: He arrived at this location at approximately 0530 and observed the front door glass was broken out at the Fire Wok restaurant. He did not have a phone on him and went to The Pig restaurant located in the same building and asked Anna Boston to call the Sheriff's Office. William Pringle completed a sworn written Statement.

Unknown suspect(s) entered and exited the business through the broken front door. While inside suspect(s) broke into the cash register and went through the restaurant pulling thing out and leaving the entire restaurant in shambles.

I made contact with the restaurant owner, Mei Guo, and advised her business had been broken into. She arrived on scene. She said she closed and locked the restaurant at 2230 last night.

BURGLARY TO BUSINESS

On 05-08-2016 I responded to 1670 Wells Rd in reference to a report of a burglary. Upon arrival I observed the glass from the front door smashed on the ground. There was an audible alarm coming from inside the business.

After securing the business, it was observed that the area immediately behind the front counter had been ransacked. The cash drawers were open from both cash registers. The contents from under the counter had been thrown on the floor.

I then made contact with two of the business employees, Ri Zheng and Yan Yang. They advised me they were missing \$300.00 in coins from under the counter. They also said their Samsung tablet had been taken as well.

*(Active intel)*

D/s Ehrenfeld arrived on scene and took photographs of the incident prior to the employees' entrance. He also dusted for possible latent prints, however no usable prints were obtained. No footprints were visible either.

I conducted a canvass of neighboring businesses, however they were closed at the time. The Wells Road Liquor store has a security camera that faces the area in front of the store. At the time of this report, no contact has been made with the liquor store in reference to the security footage.

This case remains active and is transferred to GIU.

In accordance to Chapter 938 of the Florida State Statute the total documented cost recovery time for my part of this investigation is 1 hours x \$25.85/hour = \$25.85
