Commit the offense of Attempted Felony Murder contrary to Florida Statute 782.051(1) by knowingly and intentionally committing a series of felonies with the intentions of going to the victim's residence to kill her.

Commit the offense of Armed Burglary to a Conveyance contrary to Florida Statute 810.08(2)(C) by knowingly and intentionally getting into the victim's vehicle with the intentions of committing a robbery.

Commit the offense of Armed Kidnapping while Causing Bodily Harm or Terror contrary to Florida Statute 787.01(1)(A)(3) by knowingly and intentionally using a knife to instill fear in the victim in order for him to give him money and take him to another location.

Commit the offense of Armed Robbery contrary to Florida Statute 812.13 (2) (A) by knowingly and intentionally holding a knife up the victim`s throat while demanding money and a ride.

On 09/06/2016 I responded to the Kangaroo located at 3128 Blanding Blvd in reference to a robbery call for service. Upon my arrival I made contact with the victim, Robert E. Williams.

The victim advised the following: He was on his way to work when he stopped at the Speedway located at 1545 Blanding Blvd to get a drink. He went inside the gas station, bought a drink and got back into his vehicle. When he sat down, the defendant, Samuel A. Cole (positively identified by his Florida Driver`s License), popped up behind his seat, put a knife to his throat with his left hand and then told him to "shut up and drive." Stunned, the victim reached his hand up when he felt the knife on his throat and it cut the top of his left hand. The defendant told him he would not hurt him if he did everything he asked him to do. The defendant demanded the victim give him his wallet and asked for money. He handed him the wallet and the defendant threw it back at him because he did not have any cash. _____ . He drove the defendant to County Road 215 and dropped him off just south of the intersection of Juniper Av. The defendant then walked northbound on foot and turned onto Juniper Av. The victim immediately called 911 and went to the Kangaroo gas station. He described the defendant as a white male, medium build, with tattoos on his arms, bald head and glasses. The defendant was wearing a white T-Shirt and jean shorts. He completed a sworn written statement.

During my encounter with the victim, he was shaking uncontrollably and stated many times that he was in fear for his life during the encounter with the defendant. The victim had a small laceration on his hand but refused public safety.

At 0453 hours, an additional call came in in reference to a suspicious male trying to break into a house at 4855 Joan Av. The caller, Bob, advised dispatch that it was a white bald male wearing a white T-Shirt and glasses. Sgt. Vore (6564) and Sgt. Collins (0615) responded to the residence and found the defendant on the porch with his girlfriend. They then placed the defendant into custody. Sgt. Vore read the defendant his rights from a prepared card to which he advised he understood. When asked how he got to the house, he advised _____ When asked who gave him a ride, he advised _____ ' I responded to the scene with the victim for a show up. Upon arrival, the victim positively identified the defendant. (EX)

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Contact was made with the homeowner and Elizabeth Davis (girlfriend, victim, positively identified by her Florida Driver`s License) by D/S A. Mack. E. Davis advised the defendant was acting crazy earlier because he was drunk. They left him off of Blanding Blvd due to his antics and went home. The defendant called her multiple times about getting a ride back home and argued with her. When he showed back up at her residence, he was trying to get in through the front and back doors. She advised she was in fear for her life and thought that if he came into the house, she would have to shoot him. She advised she loaded a gun and had it with her initially but did not take it outside with her. She did say, however, that she did not give the defendant a ride to the house. The homeowner, Corey Lee Loue, completed a voluntary consent to search for his residence and property. The knife was found under the front left tire of a vehicle parked in the driveway and matched the description provided by the victim and D/S C. Stivers 7722 from a previous encounter with the defendant. The white T-Shirt that belonged to the defendant was found in the water pump room at the rear of the premises. D/S J. Drury photographed the scene at 4855 Joan Av. Please see his supplement for additional information. E. Davis advised she was going to marry him and declined to provide a sworn written statement.

Contact was made with the Speedway cashier, Ashley Roth (involved other, positively identified by her Florida Driver`s License) by D/S T. Fennick 7416. She advised the defendant came inside of the gas station just before 0400 hours and asked to use her phone to call his wife. She overheard parts of their conversation.

ex / Active

defendant walked out of the store as the victim walked into the gas station. He then got into the back of the victim`s vehicle. A copy of the video footage was collected and submitted into evidence. A. Roth completed a sworn written statement. D/S T. Fennick processed the victim`s vehicle and wallet for any physical evidence. Please see his supplemental report for any additional information.

Attempted Felony Murder is being charged based upon the following: The defendant argued with his girlfriend on the phone, and was visibly and emotionally distraught. According to the store clerk, he was hung up on by her three times, and he left the Speedway visibly upset. He immediately kidnapped a stranger who was on his way to work, held him at knifepoint, and commanded him to drive him to Juniper and CR 215 so he could "kill" his girlfriend. The defendant immediately got into a verbal

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altercation, and then told his girlfriend that they should move behind the house where they could talk. That is when patrol deputies moved in on him and took him into custody.

D/S B. Elrod transported the defendant to the Orange Park Substation. I made contact with the defendant and placed him in interview room 1 for an audio and visual recorded interview. I read the defendant his rights from a Constitutional Rights waiver form (CCSO/P-023) to which he advised he understood and initialed the form. When asked about the events that occurred that night, he declined to make any comments.

The defendant was placed into custody and transported to the Clay County Jail without further incident.
